

A SCENIC WALK · 2.25 MILES EACH WAY · 4.5 MILES ROUND TRIP

# Walk to the *Red Lion* at Kniveton

From the cattle grid at Mulino Lodge, a gentle route across fields, tracks and footpaths drops down into Kniveton village and an award-winning CAMRA pub. Expect a warm welcome, real cider, proper ale and excellent homemade food.

**DISTANCE** (each way)

2.25 miles · 3.6 km

**THE WALK DOWN**

45 minutes

**THE WALK BACK**

45–60 minutes, uphill

**ROUND TRIP**

4.5 miles total

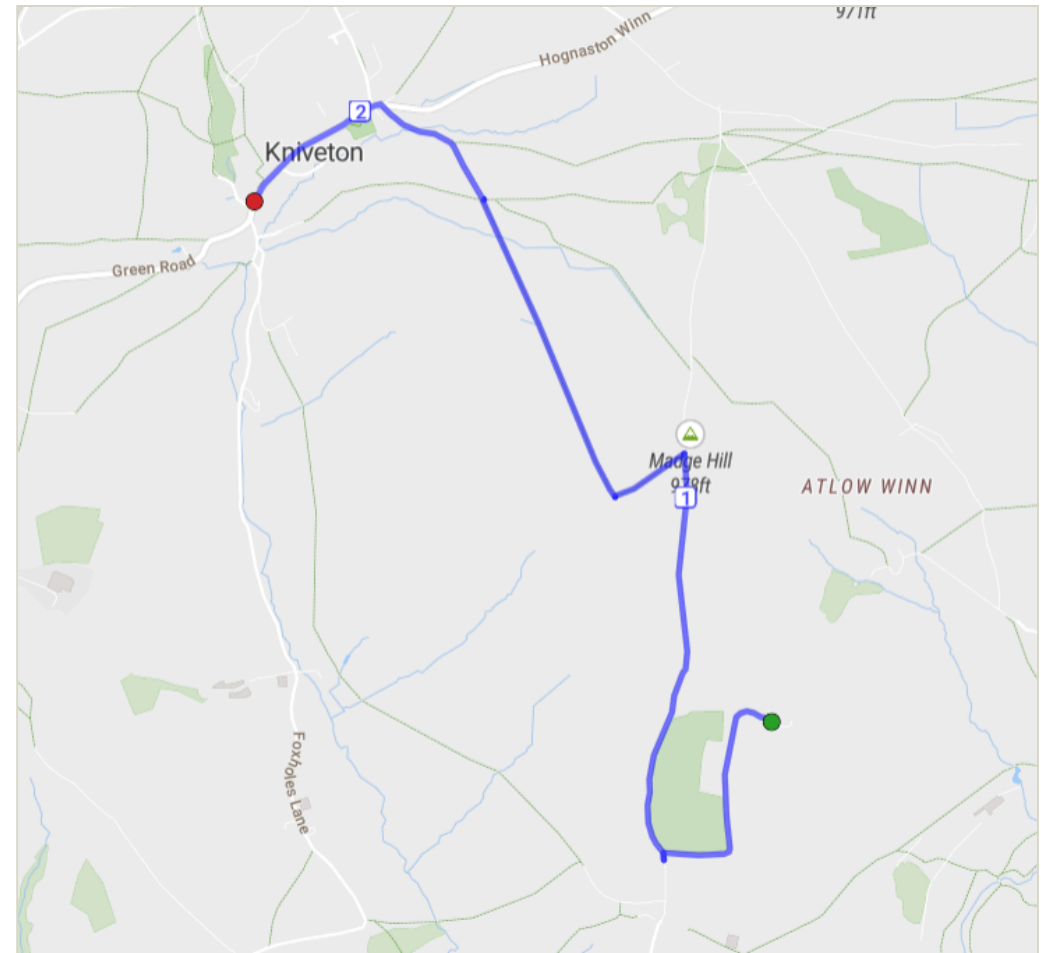

## Step-by-step *directions*

OUTWARD · 45 MIN

- 01 From the farm cattle grid, follow the farm drive back down to the green gate and steep entrance.
- 02 Turn right up the narrow lane.
- 03 Proceed through the first gate and follow the track.
- 04 The track widens out. When it narrows again, take the bridleway on your left shortly after.
- 05 Follow the boundary fence to a sheep handling area.
- 06 Once past the sheep handling area, bear right and follow the boundary fence through three fields.
- 07 Cross a small brook which leads onto a track (where there is a building).
- 08 Follow the track down into the village until you meet the main road near the school.
- 09 Turn left – the Red Lion is on the right-hand side at the bottom of the village.

### THE RETURN JOURNEY

Simply retrace your steps back to Mulino Lodge. Allow 45 minutes to 1 hour – the route is mostly uphill on the way home.
